- Daily Hours: M-F, 7:45 a.m. - 5:45 p.m.
- This program is held at the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer, where there are ten acres of woods and an outdoor fenced play area.
- The modern building has pleasant classrooms, kitchen, and indoor recreation space.
- A qualified, experienced group leader is responsible for each of our four age-level groups of 10-13 students. Additional staff is present for field trips and for swimming.
- There is quiet reading time every day, and encouragement to complete summer assignments.
- We work hard to provide a calm, structured, safe environment with high standards for behavior.



Group time Activities

Every summer at the After School Club, we include a 45-minute “group time” period on Mondays and Wednesdays.

This time allows teaching the skills of relationships—communication, trust, problem solving, empathy, and cooperation, and they provide opportunities to address issues of power, privilege, and discrimination.

Each year, we pick a new theme to help the children learn and practice these skills. We plan activities that make learning social skills fun!

A flexible program

A joint ministry of the United Methodist Church of Woburn and the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer

Our program

- Designed for students who are entering grades K-8.
- Children have many choices daily: arts and crafts, supervised free play in the woods, games, special science or cooking projects, music, etc.
- Children are grouped by age, with 10-13 children per adult.
- These small groups go swimming at the North Woburn public pool daily,
- Field trips on Tuesdays and Thursdays, except during the VBS* week.
- Staff ratios vary according to the nature of the trip, with 5-10 children per adult.
- Field trip transportation is by school bus, generally with seat belts.
- Every Monday is Munchin' Monday when we offer lunch as part of the program.

Don't pay for days you do not need. We offer summer fun one day at a time.

A Typical Day (no field trip)

- 7:45 Early morning indoor free time
- 8:30 Free time, indoors & out
- 10:00 Snack
- 10:15 1st group swims; others - choice of activities
- 11:45 Lunch & reading; 2nd group swims; others - choice of activities
- 1:15 3rd group swims; others - choice of activities
- 2:45 Snack
- 3:00 4th group swims; others - choice of activities
- 4:30 Late afternoon free time

Weekly Schedule

Each week has a theme. While all participants will enjoy a wide variety of activities every day, many options will involve the chosen theme.

*Vacation Bible School (VBS)

Children can attend Vacation Bible School (VBS) from 9 a.m. to noon each day. It is an action-packed, high-energy week. About 80 children and youth attend.

ASC students will swim every afternoon, and all days are priced at the non field trip rate. Children in grade 6 or above may serve as VBS helpers. There is an additional \$25 fee for the 5-morning VBS program.



Fee Schedule

One-time fees:

Registration (includes pool pass and tee shirt that must be worn for all field trips) **\$35**

Daily fees:

Non field trip days (all M, W, & F),
7:45 - 5:45, including 2 snacks **\$43**

Field trip days (T& TH),
7:45 - 5:45, including field trip
& 2 snacks **\$59**

Children may be registered for as many days as desired.

Discounts are available for families with multiple siblings, as well as for active members of either sponsoring church.

Pay the entire summer tuition in full by June 10 (including waitlisted days, if any) and receive an additional discount.

No additional money is ever required for field trips.
