## Who?

- Woburn children, grades K-8, from the Woburn School System. Vacations from all communities.
- For schools - call for more information.
- Limited to 45 children each day.

## What?

- A safe, caring place to be until parents return from work.
- A program emphasizing values of cooperation, sharing, respect, and responsibility.
- A balanced menu of large group, small group, and individual activities.
- Homework help, plus consistent emphasis on academic achievement and enrichment.
- Daily silent reading time, year round.
- Daily choices among activities such as sports, board games, arts and crafts, science, and cooking, plus special events.
- Snack provided each day.

## When?

- From 2:20 until 5:45 p.m. on all days school is in session.
- Full afternoon care on early release days, at no additional cost.
- All day care during December, February, and April school vacation weeks, at additional cost.
- Full day summer program, at additional cost, except last week of August.

## Where?

- At the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer, 60 Forest Park Rd. (corner of Alfred St. in North Woburn).
- A ten-acre site with woods to explore, a basketball hoop, and a fenced outdoor play area.
- A modern building with pleasant classrooms, kitchen, indoor space for games during bad weather.

## Why?

- To meet the needs of working parents and of growing children for safe, caring, age-appropriate after school care.

- A joint ministry of the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer and the United Methodist Church of Woburn.

## How?

- Children may register for one, two, three, four, or five days per week.
- Monthly cost:
  - \$440 for five days a week
  - \$380 for four days a week
  - \$320 for three days a week
  - \$260 for two days a week
  - \$130 for one day a week (Rates subject to change)
- 20% discount for additional siblings.
- Fees include transportation, snacks, and care on scheduled early release days.
- Some financial assistance is available.
